

Celebrate the Viking Way with Free Activity Day in Caistor this May

Families are invited to enjoy a fun-filled day out in Caistor as a free Family Activity Day comes to the town on **Sunday 17 May**.

Organised by Caistor Arts & Heritage Centre, as part of the Lincolnshire Wolds Outdoor Festival, the Activity Day will feature children's entertainment, activities, competitions and more, alongside street food and live music throughout the day.

This year's theme for the Lincolnshire Wolds Outdoor Festival celebrates 50 years of the Viking Way, and with this historic walking route passing directly through the town, Caistor offers the perfect place to join the celebrations.

The Caistor Activity Day will take place at **South Street Park, LN7 6LP**, on **Sunday 17 May**, from **10am to 4pm**. Viking fancy dress is encouraged!

Visitors will also be able to enjoy organised walks, including the **Caistor Tree Trail**. This guided stroll around the historic market town highlights 20 different species of trees, with opportunities to learn how to identify them, explore their traditional uses, discover their benefits to wildlife, and uncover the folklore associated with them.

The **Caistor Tree Trail** takes place from **10am to 12.30pm** and meets at **Caistor Arts & Heritage Centre**. This walk costs £2 per person to cover insurance costs. For more details, visit:

History lovers will also be able to explore Caistor's past with a guided walk entitled **"From Romans through Georgians and Victorians – what makes Caistor unique?"** This walk through the Conservation Area takes in centuries of change. This hilly Wolds town on the Viking Way reveals its Roman heritage, alongside strong Georgian influence and clear signs of Victorian pride. Today, Caistor is undergoing active regeneration of its valuable historic assets.

This walk takes place from **2pm to 3.30pm**, meeting in **Caistor Market Place**. The walk costs £2 per person to cover insurance costs. For more details, visit:
