

Fix my Street

- Hedges - The Close- reported- status enforcement- Closed the report and still taking action
 - Potholes on Eastfield/Bradway reported via a resident- - missed pothole- FIXED
 - Gateways to protect the watercourse Bransby- FIXED
 - Road surface Elongated pothole at the entrance to The Glebe- FIXED
 - Shingles spilt on Saxilby Road- NO ACTION
 - It was noted that the surfaces on the footpaths from Tillbridge Road to Kisgate-Does not meet intervention levels but passed onto Highways for consideration to include in the next Slurry Seal cycle.
 - Bradway to Upper Close and Upper Close to Fleets Road are in poor condition. Two of which are subject to flooding. Reported to Fix My Street- Being assessed. No update yet.
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- The two wooden bus shelters are to be replaced by LCC for a less enclosed design to deter ASB. Design specifications will be ¼ sides, solid back panel and see through. It is likely that the colour will not match current bus shelters in the village.
Lincolnshire County Council would will take full responsibility for:
 - Installation (4-6 months)
 - Ongoing cleaning
 - Future maintenance costs
- The wet pour maintenance could not be carried out as expected as with current high temperatures the rubber would not cure. The wet pour maintenance for the village hall playpark is still scheduled for a dry day. A playpark closed sign has been prepared and a temporary lock will be arranged to secure the playpark whilst the wet pour is drying.
- Community engagement exercise – Suggestion from The Show Committee.
- The materials for the planters have been purchased for Mens Sheds.
- The first cut of Jubilee Wood is due this month w/c 22nd June

- Bomber memorial – A request for local knowledge to inform records whether that's a detail about the crew, a photograph, or information about how the memorial is cared for today.
- Farm Woodland Payment Claim Form for Jubilee Wood has been submitted.
- Correspondence from the Quickline build team stated that reinstatements had been rectified. When asked for a log of areas which had received remedial works, a meeting was requested to discuss areas still outstanding.
- Councillor Training and Refresher training available at LALC training 20th July- via zoom 6- 9pm.
- AGAR documentation has been submitted, and documents have been published as required.
- Both School Lane and Stow Road school hedges have been cut

- The tree safety surveys have been completed. Awaiting documentation.
- 3 of the 4 Speed Indicator Posts are now up. LRSP have offered to help activate and install the signs after 8th June.
The team have struggled with the post along the Marton Rd. Highways have hand dug all around and there's so much other utility equipment, that they just can't get a post in and so we are going to have to find another location, potentially on the other side of the road.
- The Artist has completed the re-alignment and sealed the mural on the electric box.
